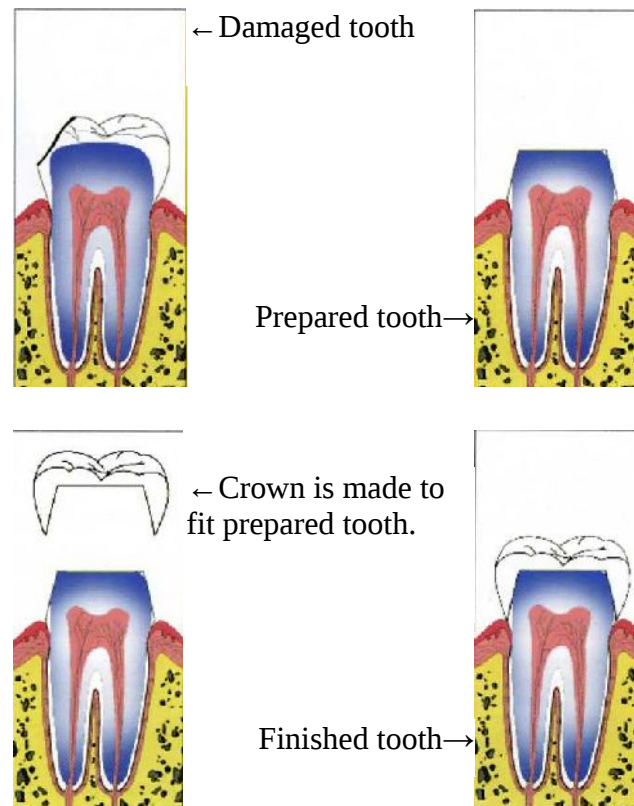
Crowns are necessary when the tooth structure is weak. Weakened teeth can be caused through large or heavily filled teeth, cracks, or fractures. Crowns are also often necessary after root canal treatment, as the tooth becomes more brittle.

A crown covers the whole visible section of the tooth. As the crown is one piece, this helps to brace the tooth to create an even pressure when biting.

Crowns are colour matched to your other teeth and look like natural teeth.

They are done in two steps:

The first is to prepare or shape the damaged tooth for the crown to fit over the top.



It takes around two weeks for the crown to be made by our technician. A temporary crown is made here at the practice to be worn over the two weeks while your crown is made.

The second step is to remove the temporary crown and fit the finished crown over the top of the shaped tooth.

The final result looks natural and can often improve the appearance of stained teeth and older silver fillings. Crowns also improve the tooth strength creating a more stable oral condition.
